2) School Advisory Committee Action Items:

A. 2019-2020 School Policy

- School calendar will be provided to SAC by the month of January each year. Calendar's for advisement by the SAC each year will be two years out. This allows families and faculty to plan accordingly.
- Use of school facilities outside of school functions: SAC requests removal of the word "regular" school programs. Use does not interfere with school programs.
- Update to graduation requirements: provide clarification on policy established last year. Pre-AP and IB classes will not be considered for weight. There is clarification on the classes required for students to

graduate. Credit by examination is getting omitted from one portion but can still be addressed under the alternate sources section. The final part is evaluating student records from non-accredited classes.

A vote of yes means we recommend the school adopt the proposed changes. A vote no means we recommend the school not adopt the changes. For the vote, 7 members voted yes. No members opposed. 1 member abstained.
