

College Entrance Examination Information for Kwajalein Schools

Update 3/21/20

Below is the most updated information we have from The College Board and ACT, Inc. for your awareness and planning:

AP Testing Information as of 3/21/2020

Please understand that some changes will be made for Kwajalein since school is in session and still able to proctor exams for students. More details will follow from The College Board on April 3, 2020. Here is the information from The College Board:

- For the 2019-20 exam administration only, students can take a 45-minute online exam. Educator-led development committees are currently selecting the exam questions that will be administered.
- Some students may want to take the exam sooner rather than later, while the content is still fresh. Other students may want more time to practice. For each AP subject, there will be two different testing dates. **This may be different for Kwajalein's AP students since we are still in school. We are currently working with The College Board to determine our options.**
- AP curricula are locally developed and we defer to local decisions on how best to help students complete coursework. To be fair to all students, some of whom have lost more instructional time than others, the exam will only include topics and skills most AP teachers and students have already covered in class by early March.
- Colleges support this solution and are committed to ensuring that AP students receive the credit they've worked this year to earn. For decades, colleges have accepted a shortened AP Exam for college credit when groups of students have experienced emergencies.
- The exam questions are designed in ways that prevent cheating. We use a range of digital security tools and techniques, including plagiarism detection software, to protect the integrity of the exams. Scoring at-home work for an AP Exam isn't new to the AP Program. For years the AP Program has received and scored at-home student work as part of the exams for the AP Computer Science Principles and AP Capstone™ courses.
- Information about the reduced scope of content that will be covered on each 2020 AP Exam is currently posted on [AP Central®](#). The specific test dates and the free-response question types will all be posted by April 3. We'll also unlock any relevant free-response questions in AP Classroom for digital use so students can access all practice questions of the type that will appear on the exam.

SAT Testing Information as of 3/21/2020

- The May 2, 2020 SAT has been cancelled for Kwajalein.
- *The June 6, 2020 SAT test window has been opened for Kwajalein High School but we are working with SAT to determine what exams will be offered for our students (Subject Tests only or full SAT).*

- More details on the June 6 SAT test will be published as soon as details are thoroughly planned with the guidance of The College Board.

ACT Testing Information as of 3/21/2020

- The April 4, 2020 ACT has been cancelled for Kwajalein.
- The June 13, 2020 ACT test window has been opened for Kwajalein High School.
- At this time it does not look like students can register for the June 13 ACT online. ACT, Inc. is working to get all test center changes in place over the next week or two.
- More details on the June 13 ACT test will be published as soon as details are thoroughly planned with the guidance of The College Board.
